His work has taken him to over 20 states, Scotland, Grand Cayman, and 2 provinces in Canada providing trail education, planning and design services. He has been involved in trail development from concept to completion for just about every type of trail imaginable: equestrian trail, hiking trail, multi use trail, OHV trail and mountain bike trails and bike parks.

Woody has influenced trails here in Sisters, by presenting 2 Road to Trail Conversion Workshops (2013-2014) for the USFS and STA and has recently worked with the 242 Bike Park committee on planning and concept design for the proposed new bike park. Trails are a wonderful outdoor recreation activity for all including families and children.

His presentation will focus on why trails are an important outdoor recreation facility and provide ideas on ways to make trails interesting to children and their families. His passion for trails is infectious and he is always willing to share his trail wisdom with anyone wanting to learn more about trails.
